**Release and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement**

This Release and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement is made by and between the Azurite Press MCEO (including its Speakers, Directors and all of its affiliates) (collectively the “APMCEO”) and the parent or legal guardian (“Parent/Guardian”) of the minor person \_\_\_\_\_ (“Minor”).

Upon APMCEO’s acceptance of the signed Parental Consent/Minor Permission and the Release and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement from Parent/Guardian, Minor will be permitted to attend and participate in the APMCEO event (including workshop, modules and/or related activities) (“APMCEO Event”) which has been specified in the Parental Consent/Minor Permission, subject to all terms and conditions stipulated in this agreement.

APMCEO and Parent/Guardian agree to all of the following terms and conditions:

- 1) Parent/Guardian certifies that Minor is at least 16 years of age, which is the minimum age that APMCEO will permit a minor to attend an APMCEO Event where Minor is accompanied by a Parent/Guardian;
- 2) APMCEO requires that both Minor and Parent/Guardian must be registered for the APMCEO Event and that both Minor and Parent/Guardian attend the APMCEO Event. Minors will not be permitted into the APMCEO Event or conference/event rooms where both persons are registered but the Parent/Guardian does not physically attend the APMCEO Event;
- 3) APMCEO reserves the right to reject registration for any event that is sponsored by APMCEO and without any reason given in making such a decision;
- 4) Parent/Guardian may authorize another person to accompany Minor to the event on their behalf (through a notarized written authorization submitted to the APMCEO, at least one month prior to the APMCEO Event, which states that Parent/Guardian has assigned a designated responsible adult to accompany Minor and act on Parent/Guardian’s behalf), however this is subject to APMCEO’s agreement and does not discharge the Parent/Guardian from the terms and conditions of this agreement;
- 5) Parent/Guardian has informed himself/herself and Minor of the general nature of the Azurite Press MCEO educational materials, programs and the techniques used therein;

6) Parent/Guardian has read, fully understands and agrees to the **Notice of Claims, Consent and Commitment** on the Azurite Press website (see [http://www.azuritepress.com/claims\\_consent\\_commitment.html](http://www.azuritepress.com/claims_consent_commitment.html)) and the **Terms, Conditions, Agreements and Implied Consent** therein and has fully informed Minor of the contents therein;

7) By Parent/Guardian's consent to Minor's participation in the APMCEO event, Parent/Guardian accepts and assumes full responsibility for the behavior of Minor during the APMCEO Event and during Minor's stay or visitation upon the general premises, rooms or venue where the APMCEO Event is held;

8) Parent/Guardian and Parent/Guardian's personal representatives, assigns, successors, heirs or administrators hereby release, waive, discharge and hold harmless the Azurite Press MCEO (APMCEO), its Speakers, employees, associates, representatives and agents from any and all claims, demands, losses, costs, liabilities or damages whatsoever arising out of or related to Minor's behavior, actions, participation or involvement in the APMCEO event and related activities;

9) Parent/Guardian hereby indemnifies the Azurite Press MCEO (APMCEO), its Speakers, employees, associates, representatives and agents from any claim made or from any action taken by a third party against the Azurite Press MCEO (APMCEO), its Speakers, employees, associates, representatives and agents arising out of or related to Minor's behavior, actions, participation or involvement in the APMCEO event and related activities;

10) Any claim or controversy arising out of or relating to this agreement will be submitted to a court of competent jurisdiction in the state of Arizona;

11) Any changes or modifications may not be made to this agreement except by writing and must be agreed to and signed by both parties;

12) Parent/Guardian understands that the APMCEO is relying on Parent/Guardian's agreement to all the terms and conditions herein in order to permit Minor to attend the APMCEO Event; and

13) Parent/Guardian has carefully read and reviewed this Release and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement and fully understands and freely and voluntarily consents to all the terms and conditions herein.
